

AAPS OFFICERS NON-ENDORSEMENT POLICY

The AAPS officers (president-elect, president, past president and treasurer) are very prestigious and visible positions within the Association and are frequently asked to give recommendations, endorsements, or nominations for awards or fellows. To avoid the appearance of misuse of these offices, the Executive Council has decided that during their term, the persons serving in the above positions will not give recommendations or endorsements, nominate, or write letters of support on behalf of anyone for any AAPS award, including fellow status. The holder of these offices will not serve as Section representatives or on other committees, unless assigned by the Executive Council.
